WA, JDC, JNF and Israel Bonds are among the most prominent, relevant, established agencies that have funded, developed and continue to service a wide range of programs, meeting basic human needs in Israel. In Giving Wisely, Dr. Jaffe undertook the mammoth task of compiling factual data about the literally hundreds of smaller, less known health and social welfare agencies providing important and often very specialized services describing their purpose, history, programs, budgets and needs. More than three hundred from A(Achusat Sara Children's Home) to Z (Zion Orphanage) are included.

The agencies are listed alphabetically, with a subject index code so that the programs are readily identifiable.

While the major purpose of this volume was to attract and inform potential donors, it also serves as a valuable reference guide for social workers in Israel, and for Americans interested in learning more about and/or seeking volunteer opportunities for themselves in lesser known agencies in Israel.
